



GUIDELINES FOR LIFE MEMBERSHIP OF ACT & SOUTHERN NSW RUGBY UNION

Clause 5 of the ACT & Southern NSW Rugby Union Limited constitution provides that any person who has rendered distinguished service to rugby union football may be elected in accordance at any AGM as a Life Member. The procedure for nominating and electing Life Members may be determined by the Board from time to time.

The Board, following consultation with existing Life Members, has resolved the following process for the appointment of Life Members:

- Consideration must be given to the nominee's distinguished service within the ACT & Southern NSW region including at the community, local club & school level.
- The nominee's rugby involvement may have been as a player, coach, referee, or administrator or as a hands-on active supporter.
- Any nomination must clearly show the nominee's commitment & involvement in rugby & its beneficial effect on rugby in the region over at least a 10-year period.
- Any nomination will be made on the "Nomination for Life Membership of the ACT & Southern NSW Rugby Union" form (below). The nomination is to be supported by a proposer & a seconder who are both Voting Members of the Union. The nomination must be made at least 60 days before the Annual General Meeting at which the person is to be elected.
- Alternatively, a person may be nominated by the Chairperson of the Board of ACT & Southern NSW Rugby Union Limited on behalf of the Board following a unanimous resolution of the Board.
- All nominations will be considered by the Board of ACT & Southern NSW Rugby Union. If there is Board support for a nominee, a recommendation by the Board is to be made at the Annual General Meeting.
- In considering nominations the Board shall seek the opinion of the current Life Members as to the nominees' suitability.
- The final decision on recommending nominees for Life Membership at the Annual General Meeting is the responsibility of the Board.
- The maximum number of Life Members remain at 20 & only a maximum of 2 Life Members can be nominated in any one calendar year.
- The President of the ACT & Southern NSW Rugby Union Limited Board will be responsible for coordinating the administrative arrangements & shall be the point of contact regarding nominations.

A Life Member is entitled to receive notices of, to attend, & to speak at general meetings of the ACT & Southern NSW Rugby Union Limited. All such notices shall be provided via the Life Members Representative.
